PART I. COOPERATIVES

TITLE I. COMMON PROVISIONS

SECTION I. THE COOPERATIVE AND ITS STATUTE

Article 1. § 1. A cooperative shall be a voluntary association of an unlimited number of persons, of variable membership and variable share fund, which conducts joint economic activity in the interests of its members.

§ 2. A cooperative may conduct social, educational and cultural activities for the benefit of its members and their community.

Article 2. A cooperative shall conduct its activity on the basis of this Act, other Acts and a registered statute.

Article 3. The property of the cooperative shall be the private property of its members.

Article 4. Repealed.

Article 5. § 1. The statute of a cooperative shall specify :

1) the name of a cooperative with the addition of the word “spółdzielnia” or “spółdzielczy” (“cooperative”) and its seat;

2) the object of the cooperative’s activity and the duration thereof if it is established for a definite period;

3) the value of the admission fee and the value and number of shares which a member is obliged to declare, time limits of paying and withdrawing a share and the
